

Pressure-Mounted Baby Gate Installation



A pressure-mounted baby gate is used to keep a young child away from an unsafe area in the home. It stays in place by pressing against a wall or door frame. If using this gate to prevent access to stairs, it should **only be installed at the bottom of the staircase**, not the top.



Remember: Always follow the complete instructions that come with your baby gate. This sheet is not meant to replace the product instructions.

Most pressure-mounted gates do not require tools for installation, but you may need a tape measure and a pencil.

How to Install:

- 1. Measure the area to make sure the gate will fit across the space that you want to close off.
- 2. Attach any extra parts, like pressure bumpers or wall cups, based on your gate model.
- 3. Put the gate in the doorway or between two walls, making sure the bottom touches the floor.
- 4. Pull the sides of the gate to make it fit snugly. The pressure bumpers should be pressed firmly against the door frame or wall on both sides.
- 5. Tighten the gate by turning the handle or adjusting the pressure bumpers to lock it into place. Check the gate by pulling on it to make sure it doesn't move.

Your pressure-mounted gate is now ready to use! Always follow the manufacturer's instructions for safety.
