







IWK CHIRPP DATA REPORT

The Canadian Hospitals Injury Reporting and Prevention Program (CHIRPP) is an injury and poisoning surveillance system that collects and analyzes data on injuries to people who are seen at emergency departments of 11 pediatric hospitals and 9 general hospitals in Canada including at the IWK. This infographic highlights injuries seen at the IWK Emergency Department only (2023).



● Closed Head Injury: minor head injury, concussion ● Superficial: bruises, abrasion ● Soft Tissue injury: sprain, strain ● Laceration: cut, open wound ● Fracture
