BOOSTER SEAT LESSON CERTIFICATE

Today, we measured	to see if they <i>might</i> be ready to use a seat belt.
Results:	

- Your child is less than 145 cm (4 feet 9 inches) tall.
 Your child needs to use a booster seat on every ride to stay safe.
- Your child is at least 145 cm (4 feet 9 inches) tall.
 Your child *might* be ready for a seat belt. Check to see if the seat belt fits properly.

The seat belt must fit properly in order to keep your child safe:

- ✓ Does the shoulder belt cross the chest and stay between the neck and the shoulder?
- ✓ Does the lap belt stay low and snug across the hip bones?
- ✓ When sitting all the way back, do the child's knees bend comfortably over the edge of the vehicle seat?

If the seat belt does not fit your child in this way, continue to use a booster seat until the seat's height or weight limits have been exceeded. Children under 13 are safest in the back seat.
